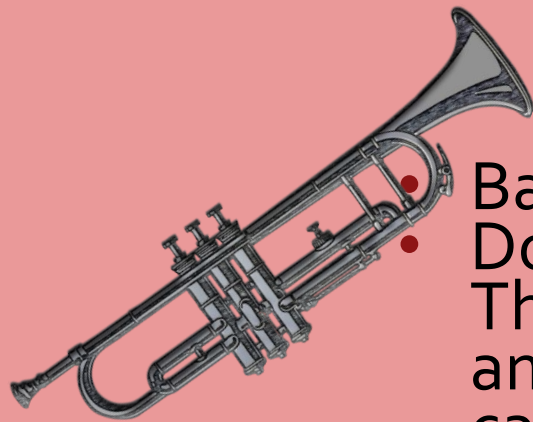
Visual Arts Class: What can I expect?
